Over the years, HTML coders have become sloppy, because Web browser software was originally written to tolerate many variations in HTML

coding, but, with XHTML, coders must conform to the XML rules. Whereas HTML is an application of SGML, a very flexible markup language, XHTML is an application of XML, a more restrictive subset of SGML.
